

**Articles of Association
Augusta College Echo Hall Association**

Name. The name of the organization is Augusta College Echo Hall Association.

Location. Augusta College Echo Hall Association is located in Augusta, Kentucky, 41002.

Purpose. Augusta College Echo Hall Association is organized exclusively for charitable and other purposes under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Governance. Augusta College Echo Hall Association is an unincorporated association governed in accordance with its Bylaws and adheres to the principles of charity, goodwill, truth and fairness. No part of the net earnings of the Association shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Association shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the Association's purpose.


Operations. As a non-profit charitable organization, Augusta College Echo Hall Association voluntarily undertakes and supports charitable efforts to preserve, rehabilitate and operate Echo Hall, an original dormitory of the Augusta College. Augusta College was one of the first Methodist colleges in the world and Echo Hall is on the National Register of Historic Places. The Association will acquire the Echo Hall property in order to prevent demolition of a unique building intrinsic to the historic identity of the City of Augusta and its residents. Other projects and activities include securing the building against further deterioration, renovating the facility for public and community use and utilizing the facility for education, charitable and community purposes. The Association also may conduct programs and activities to enhance community awareness of the history of the Augusta College and the City of Augusta and contribute to the city's cultural heritage. No substantial part of the activities of the Association shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Association shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Dissolution. Should Augusta College Echo Hall Association be dissolved for any reason, assets of the Association shall be distributed for exempt purposes only within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.


Amendments. Amendments to the Articles of Association may be enacted by two-thirds vote of the registered membership.




